Blueberry – (1 gallon) The average family needs 4-6 bushes. You will need at least two varieties for cross-pollination. You can purchase an early and mid-season, or mid-season and late. Two plants need to be in bloom close to the same time for pollination.

Blackberry/Raspberry – (1 gallon) The average family needs 10 to 15 plants. Yield can be up to 3 to 4 pints per plant. Blackberries will need a trellis to run on. We are offering an erect Raspberry (Caroline) and one that trails (Dorman Red). Learn more at

Figs – (1 gallon) Figs are easy to grow and the rewards are great. These plants reach 10 feet tall and make great landscape specimens. Learn more at

Pomegranate Bushes – (1 gallon) Pomegranates do well in our area. Great for eating and making juices. Hardy to 7 degrees Fahrenheit and prefer soil pH of 5.5 to 7.2. They are very heat tolerant for our area. They have pretty orange flowers in the spring and are self-pollinating. Variety is 'Wonderful'. 4-5 feet tall. Learn more at
