Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 16-17 Comprehensive Transportation Plan Update

RFP No. 16-17 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Below are questions received and answers:

- A. Question: The Qualifications of Offerors section, found on page 4 of the RFP, requests that *Any contractor submitting a Proposal must complete the Contractor's/Consultant's Qualification Statement and Questionnaire provided in this package.* Form not included in RFP. Please advise.?

Answer: The Consultant's Qualification Statement and Questionnaire will not be required with the original submittal. However, it may be requested of shortlisted firms upon their selection at a later date.

- B. Question: Is the Transmittal Letter and Table of Contents included in the 30 page limit?


Answer: No.

- C. Question: Section A.2 asks for availability charts and a backlog curve and Section C requests current and projected workloads. Did you intend for us to include this information in both places?

Answer: Yes; Section A2 is specific to key personnel to be assigned to this project, and section C is referencing the company's capabilities that may serve to differentiate it from other firms. For example, if the firm believes that a main emphasis of the CTP update is operational improvements at intersections, they may want to highlight the firm's overall Traffic Engineering staff's capabilities, existing commitments and availability for this project and also indicate the firm's offices that would serve as the base of operations for such staff that would represent a good value for the county and help differentiate it from other qualified firms.
