Special Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST)

Shall a special one percent sales and use tax be continued in the special district of Rockdale County for a period of time of six years for the raising of approximately \$77,220,000 purpose of funding (a) (i) roads, streets, bridges and sidewalks, (ii) fire and 911, (iii) sheriff, (iv) recreation and senior services, (v) water and wastewater and (vi) library, all for the benefit of Rockdale County and (b) (i) public safety, (ii) roads, streets, bridges and sidewalks and (iii) parks, including greenspace and trails, all for the benefit of the City of Conyers, Georgia?
